***R* - Controlled Syllables**

The letter *r* after a vowel changes the sound of the vowel.

The *ur*, **often found in words with unpleasant meanings**, says /er/ as in *burn*, *hurt*, *burst*.

Spelling choices for *er*, *ir*, and *ur* are difficult, as they share the same sound.
