Has one long vowel located at the end of the word or syllable.

Examples: hē, pō/tā/tō, whȳ (ī), lā/dȳ (ē)

Closed Syllable:

Has one short vowel located NOT at the end of the word or syllable.

Examples: ǒn, ĭnch, băt, strĕtch, hĕl/mĕt
