

**THIS WEEK'S LESSON IS:**

**V \_ E**

**Vowel - Consonant - Silent e Syllable:**  
Has a long vowel followed by a consonant and a silent e.

Examples:  $\bar{b}i\bar{k}e$ ,  $\bar{l}o / c\bar{a}t\bar{e}$ ,  $\check{i}n / \bar{v}i\bar{t}e$ \*

$\begin{matrix} V\_E & O & V\_E & C & V\_E \end{matrix}$

**O** labeling under the vowel indicates *open syllable*.  
**C** labeling under the vowel indicates *closed syllable*.  
\* **V \_ E** labeling under the vowel indicates *vowel – consonant – silent e*.
